

Programme at a glance

- 80% ERDF-funding
- Partners from at least two countries
Clear added value from cross-border cooperation
- Regular projects: two-step application procedure
 - Max. 4 million /project
 - 2 million/partner
 - Length approximately 3 years
- Small projects: one-step application procedure
 - Max. 213 550€
 - Max. length 18 months

Choose the right programme objective

PO3: Joint circular economy solutions

Focus on reducing the amounts of virgin materials used, decreasing waste, and reusing products and materials.


Result indicator: the number of improved product/service cycles/chains

PO4: Improved coastal and marine environment

Focus on reducing the inflows of nutrients, hazardous substances, plastics, and toxins to the Baltic Sea.

Result indicator: the number of improved urban and agricultural runoff/load sources

P03 project result: improved product/service cycles/chains

The cycle or chain is improved if 1 or all 3 of the following impacts are achieved:

Reduced amounts
of virgin
materials used

Decreased
amounts of waste

Increased
amounts of
reused products
and materials

There can be more than 1 cycle/chain improved by 1 project.

Each project must define the baseline and set the target value to be achieved.

 - The project application must be submitted in the Jems system between **October 10 and October 31, 2024**, by noon Eastern European Time.
- **Call for regular projects**
