OUTCOME OF THE SILENCE PROCEDURE INITIATED BY THE PRESIDENCY OF THE NATIONAL COORDINATORS GROUP ON 8 FEBRUARY 2022

15 February 2022

The NCG is informed that the outcome of the silence procedure, launched on 8 February 2022 and completed on 14 February 2022, is as follows:

1. The silence procedure for the Communication from the National Coordinators Group to the Policy Area Bioeconomy on the Steering Group Rules of Procedure was broken. Therefore, the document will be reconsidered, revised and submitted for the second silence procedure.
2. The silence procedure for the Communication from the National Coordinators Group to the Policy Area Safe on the Steering Group Rules of Procedure was not broken and the document is deemed adopted.
3. Taking into account the decision by the Steering Group of PA Safe of 7 December 2021 (item 8 of the agenda) to approve Sjöfartsverket as the new lead PAC of PA Safe, the NCG appoints Sjöfartsverket as lead PAC of PA Safe accordingly.

The respective PAs will be informed about the outcome of the silence procedure.
