
Bothnian Coastal Route

- The new Nordic bucket list route.
- Bothnian Coastal Route gathers export ready tourism actors around and along the coast of Bothnian Bay and Kvarken strait.
- Cross border circular route via HaparandaTornio twincity in the north (coastal Lapland area) or via ferry between Umeå – Vaasa in the south.
- Connecting flights to Stockholm Arlanda and Helsinki Vantaa airports.



What's our geography?

- Connecting 13 destinations to an attractive coastal travel route.
- The environmentally friendly ferry Aurora Botnia across the Kvarken strait connects and makes it a circle route.
- 835 km of coastal attractiveness.
- Good infrastructure with public transportation along coastal highway E4 and E8 with e-car charging stations.



Day 1: Arrival in Oulu

Arrival at Oulu airport (OUL)

Several flight connections via Helsinki are available from Europe.

It is possible to rent an electric or hybrid car is at Oulu airport.

You reach Oulu city centre by buses 8, 9 and 9K from the airport. The connection is about 30 min and runs twice per hour on weekdays.

Accommodation at GreenStar Hotel in the centre of Oulu.

The closest restaurant to the hotel is Rosso, but in case you do not arrive too late, we recommend Restaurant Mallassauna.


