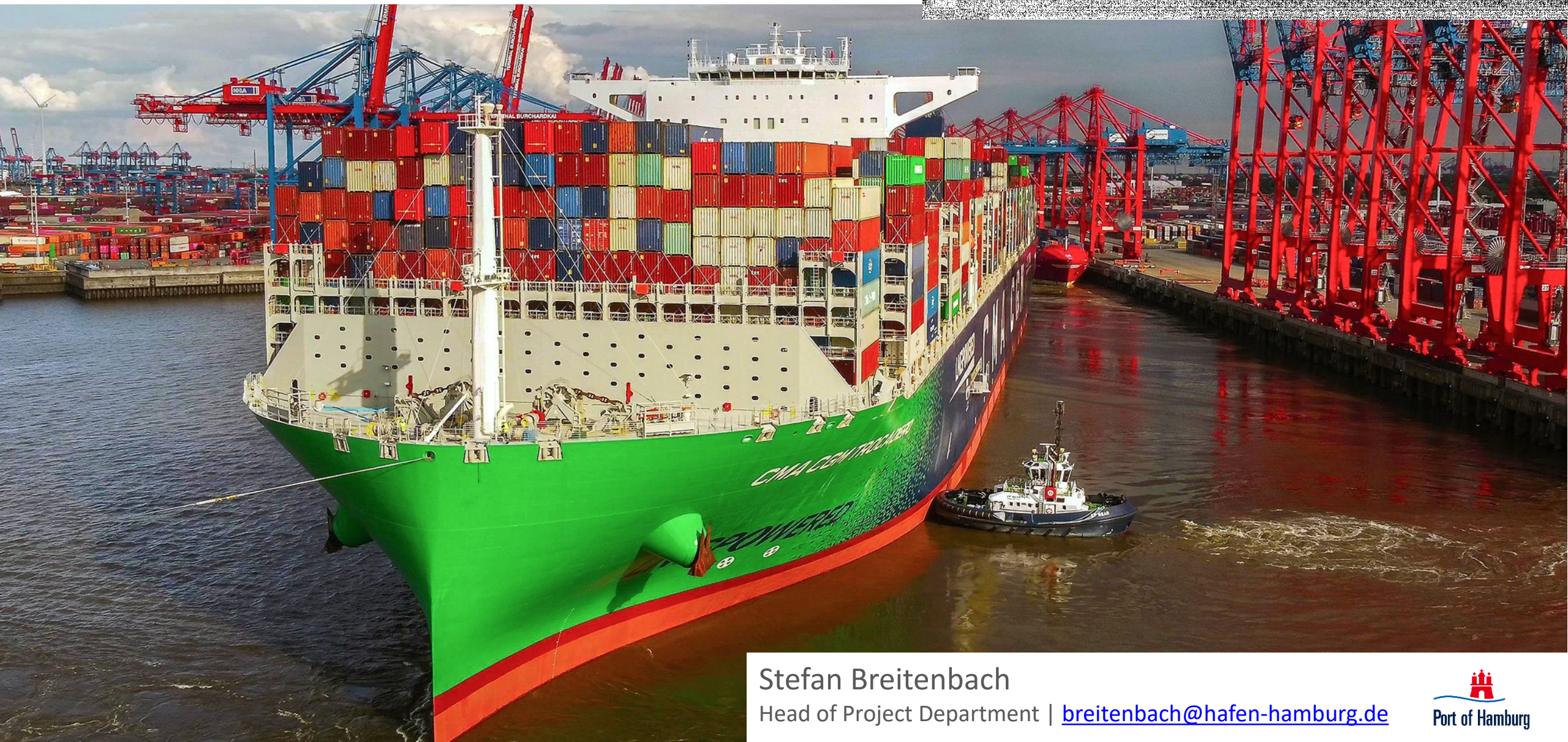

PA Ship, Action 3

Support development of shore-side facilities to enhance clean shipping measures including infrastructure for climate-neutral and clean fuels.

By providing access to climate-neutral and clean marine fuels through land-based infrastructure and shore-side facilities.

Direct support by BSC to PA Ship Actions

- Onshore power supply (OPS) solutions for small ports
- Retrofitting port handling equipment from diesel to electric (gantry cranes)
- Green bunkering and charging strategy for ports in cooperation with VASAB
